The Ringing Course is open to a limited number of young people from about ten years old. We will be teaching ringing from scratch. New learner charge to cover course materials: £10.

At the same time there will be a Ringing Club for those who can already ring with a chance to practice rounds and methods and to play ringing games.

The Ringing Course and Club will take place between 9.30 and 11.30 am on 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 August at St Helen's Church, and will include a break for refreshments and games each morning.

It usually takes some weeks before any beginner can ring a bell safely alone, so lessons will continue after the course, weekly on Fridays 5.00 pm – 6.00 pm at St Helen's, Abingdon. Alternatively the young people will be introduced to a tower closer to their home where they may continue to ring.

We invite parents of those new to ringing to visit the tower with their young people either on Friday 17 August at 6.00 pm or at 9.15 am on Monday 20 August so everyone can see what is involved.
